2. 250\$ management fee by which OIEA and ICM has agreed upon and payable by the applicant **ONLY** upon approval of the applicant's **CERTIFICATE of ELIGIBILITY (COE)** by the Japan Bureau of Immigration. (No management fee is collected if VISA is not approved)

ICM's responsibility to the applicant ceases upon the applicants visa approval by the Japanese embassy in the Philippines.

APPLICATION & PROCESSING STARTS 2: JULY – FEBRUARY (APRIL 017 OPENING)
SUBMISSION OF PROXY APPLICATION BY SCHOOL FOR COE: MID FEBRUARY
WAITING TIME FROM SUBMISSION – COE RELEASE : 2 MONTHS

STEP 1 : ATTEND AN ORIENTATION & INFO SESSION.

STEP 2 : SIGN AN UNDERTAKING WITH ICM AVAILING OF ITS SERVICES.

STEP 3 : REMIT/PAY THE AMOUNT OF 1,500 PhP to ICM

STEP 4 : PROCEED WITH THE APPLICATION.

STEP 5 : START TO STUDY JAPANESE

STEP 6 : SUBMIT COMPLETELY FILLED OUT APPLICATION ON OR BEFORE THE DEADLINE.

STEP 7 : START WORKING ON YOUR SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

STEP 8 : RECEIVE COE

STEP 8 : APPLY FOR A VISA & SUBMIT ALL DOCUMENTS + COE

STEP 9 : RECEIVE VISA & PREPARE FOR FLIGHT TO JAPAN
